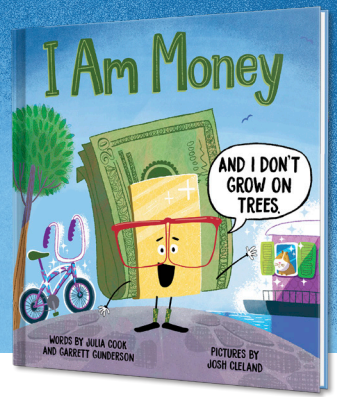

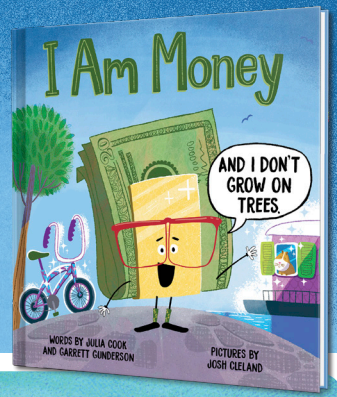

Pay yourself first! For every dollar you get, put 15 cents away in a special place. This is a great money habit to have. Always remember to take care of yourself so you can give your best to others.



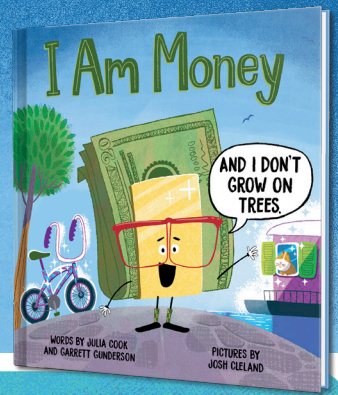
Don't spend money that you do not have.

You can work for money, and your money can also work for you if you are a smart investor. Now that's INTEREST-ing.



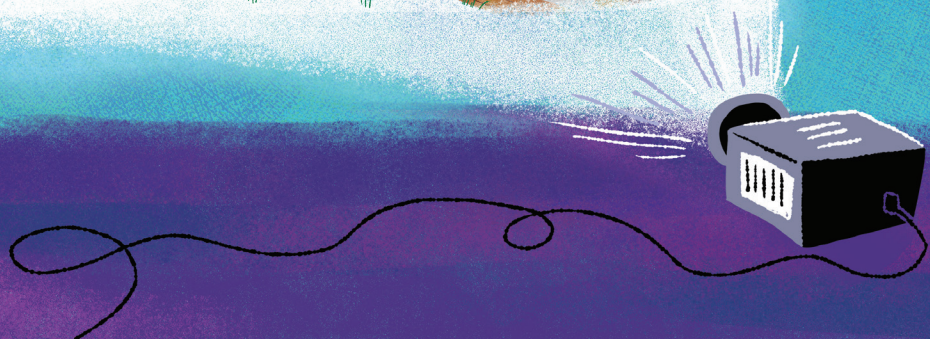
Some people are afraid to admit they don't know a lot about money. Of course, nobody knows everything. Get to know people who are good with money. Ask questions. Always keep learning.

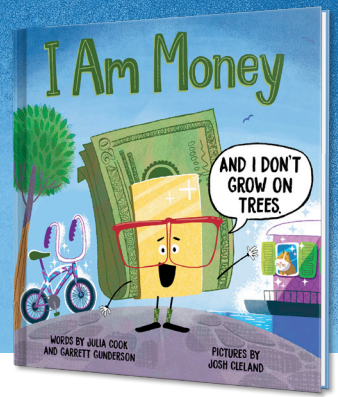
The best way to earn money is to create something that people need or want. If you can help people solve problems, you will create value... and money always chases value.

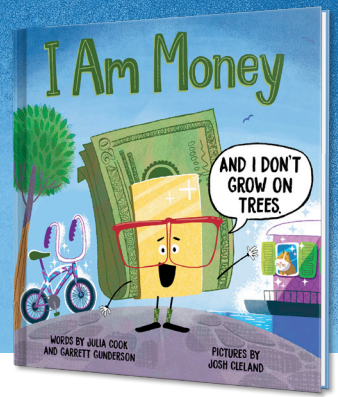

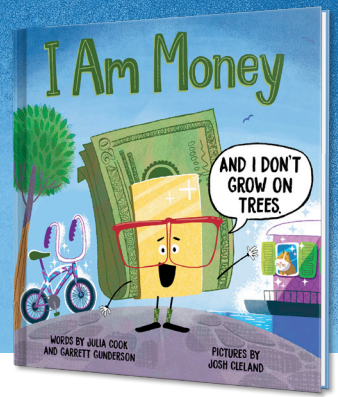
HOW TO SPEND ME

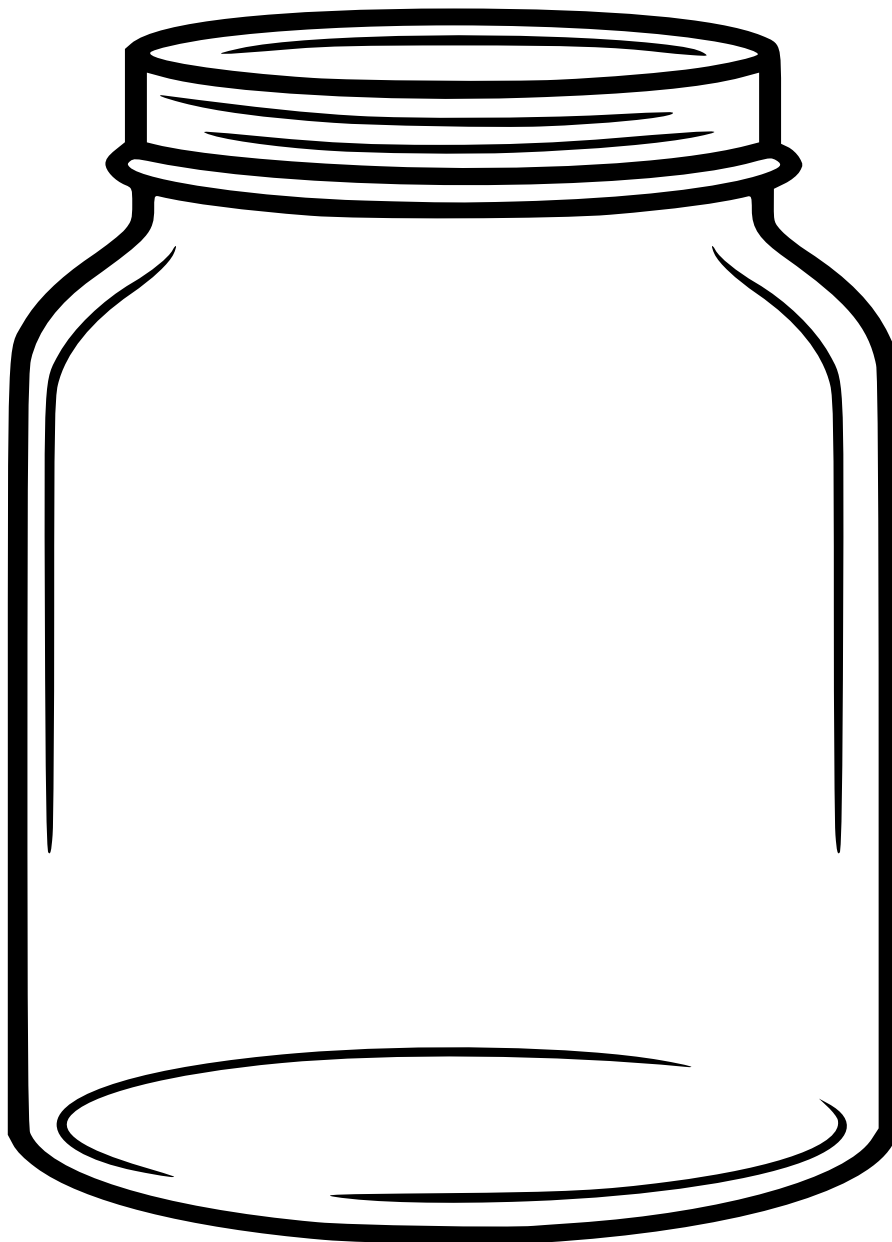

HOW TO SAVE ME

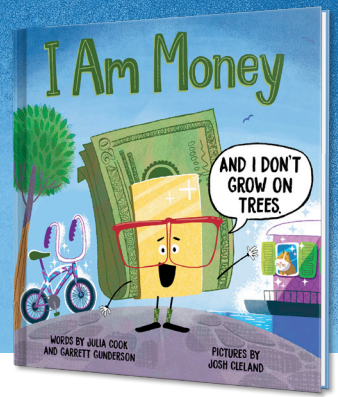
Every time you earn me, put some of me in your savings jar and watch me grow!

HOW TO GIVE ME AWAY

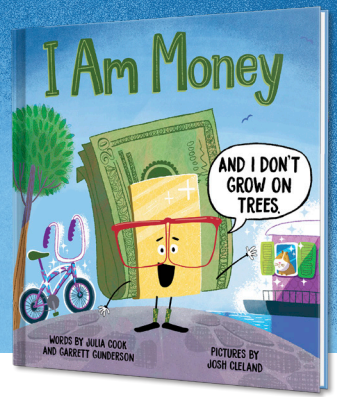
One of the coolest things you can do is share me with others! If you were going to give some money away to a cause that's important to you, what would it be?

MAKE YOUR OWN MONEY JARS

With the help of a parent or caregiver, create your own money jars for spending, saving, and sharing!

SUPPLIES

- 3 mason jars or plastic jars
- Craft foam or poster paper
- Stickers, acrylic paint pens, glitter pens, markers, colored pencils, crayons
- Glue (optional)
- Painter's tape or washi tape (optional)

INSTRUCTIONS

Lids

If you're using a mason jar:

- Remove the top part of the lid
- Trace the lid of the mason jar on craft foam or poster paper
- Cut out the circle
- Fold the circle in half
- Cut a notch in the middle of the circle. This is where you will add coins and folded up dollar bills!
- Decorate each circle however you like!
- Optional: glue the circle to the side of the lid so it stays secure
- Screw your lids onto each jar

If you're using a plastic jar lid:

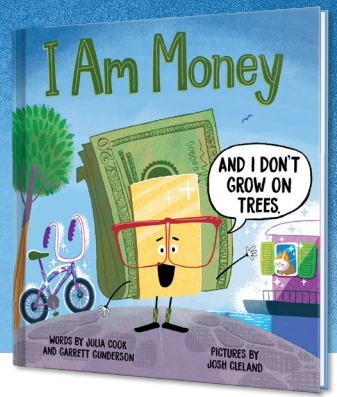
- Ask a parent to cut a notch in each jar lid using a box cutter. This is where you will add coins and dollar bills!
- Decorate your lid with acrylic markers, paint pens, or stickers
- Screw your lids onto each jar

INSTRUCTIONS

Jars

- Write "Spend," "Save," and "Give" on each jar with paint pens or glitter pens
 - (You can also write "Spend," "Save," and "Give" on painter's tape or washi tape and stick the tape to each jar)
- Decorate the jars with stickers and your own designs. You can also cut out the images below and glue or tape them to your jar!
